## **PUBLIC HEARING MINUTES**

IEPA Loan Project Number L176047 that will include removal and replacement of approximately 125 lead service lines. Project L176048 that will include the replacement of approximately 7,000 linear feet of 8 inch water main trunklines from the Water Treatment Plant to the elevated storage tank.
