A discussion was held on the union contract and approval of what Chris had corrected on it. With all in agreement that the red line copy was good to go, Chirs asked for a pay scale that was needed to be updated. Mr. Sherer stated that he would plug in the pay scale and get everyone a final copy to go over so it can be presented to the union for approval.
