ORDINANCE NO. 2014

AN ORDINANCE TO ORGANIZE TRAFFIC AROUND THE CORNERSTONE ACADEMY CAMPUS

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Mayor and Council of the City of Nokomis, to provide for the protection of the school children and citizens a more cohesive flow of traffic around the

WHEREAS, it is understood that school personnel will be responsible for the loading and unloading of children and the crossing areas along South Oak Street from East South Street and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NOKOMIS, ILLINOIS,

- 1. South Oak Street from East South Street to Capps Avenue shall be one way traffic only from South to North on school days from 7:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.
- 2. This ordinance shall be effective November 1, 2015.
- 3. Any person convicted of a violation of this ordinance shall be fined not less than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00), nor more than Seven Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$750.00) for any on offense.
