ORDINANCE TO ACCEPT TITLE

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Nokomis, Illinois that,


WHEREAS, the following described property has become a public nuisance and the City of Nokomis desires to have the real estate cleaned up for the betterment of the community:

The West Half of the North Half of Block 4 and the North 30 feet of the South Half of the West Half of Block 4 of Haller's subdivision of Block 5 of Miller and Young's Second Addition to Nokomis and all that part of Block 5 lying West of the centerline of said lot, *also* the North 129 feet of the East Half of Block 4 and all that part of Block 5 lying East of the centerline of said Block; excepting therefrom the tract of land conveyed to the People of the State of Illinois by Warranty Deed filed in Record Book 604, page 53 as Doc. No. 200000386489, all in J.E. Haller's Subdivision of Block 5 in Miller and Young's Second Addition to Nokomis, Montgomery County, Illinois.

WHEREAS the City Treasurer is directed to issue a check in the sum of \$431.04 to the Montgomery County Trustee for said real estate.

BE IT THEREFORE ORDAINED that the Mayor of the City of Nokomis is authorized to accept title concerning the above described real estate.
