

ORDINANCE NO. 429

ORDINANCE TO CONTINUE INCREASE IN CORPORATE RATE AUTHORIZED BY REFERENDUM HELD IN THE CITY OF NOKOMIS, ILLINOIS, ON THE 9th DAY OF AUGUST, A. D. 1946.

WHEREAS, the Sixty-seventh General Assembly, by House Bill #650, provided that the governing body of each city and village should establish by ordinance or resolution the tax rate for each fund for which taxes may be levied, and

WHEREAS, on the 9th day of August, A. D. 1946, the citizens of this municipality at a referendum election held as provided by law, authorized the governing body to levy a tax for corporate purposes at the rate of .4375 per cent of the assessed value of all taxable property in the municipality as ascertained and set by law.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and the City Council of the City of Nokomis, That:

Section 1. The maximum tax rate for general corporate purposes for the municipality shall be .4375 per cent of the assessed value of all taxable property in the municipality as ascertained and set by law.

Section 2. A certified copy of this ordinance shall be filed with the County Clerk within twenty days after its adoption.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, and publication as provided by law.
