# ordinance no. 433.

AN ORDINANCE CALLING A SPECIAL ELECTION IN THE CITY OF NOKOMIS, MONTGOMERY COUNTY, ILLINOIS, FOR THE PURPOSE OF SUBMITTING TO THE ELECTORS OF SAID CITY THE QUESTION OF AUTHORIZING SEWERAGE IMPROVEMENT BONDS OF SAID CITY IN THE AMOUNT OF ONE HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$100,000)

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Nokomis, Montgomery County,
Illinois, hereby finds and declares that the best interests of said City
require that the City improve the sewerage system by constructing a sewage
treatment plant and repairing and extending said system; and

WHEREAS, the Council finds that the cost of such improvement and extensions will be at least One Hundred Thousand Dollars; and

WHEREAS, before such bonds may be issued, the question of their authorization must be submitted to the electors of the City and approved by a majority of such electors voting on the question:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NOKOMIS, MONTGOMERY COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That a special election is hereby called and shall be held in the City of Nokomis, Montgomery County, Illinois, on the 10th day of 1952, for the purpose of submitting to the electors of said City the following proposition:

Shall bonds in the amount of One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000) be issued by the City of Nokomis, Illinois, for the purpose of improving the sewerage system of the City by constructing a sewage treatment plant, and repairing and extending the existing sewerage system; said bonds to mature as follows:

\$5,000 on July 1, 1954 through 1967 6,000 on July 1, 1968 through 1972

Said bonds to bear interest as follows:

Bonds due in 1954 through 1963 at 2% per annum Bonds due in 1964 through 1967 at 2-3/4% per annum Bonds due in 1968 through 1972 at 2-7/8% per annum

SECTION 2. That said election shall be held at the following polling
