WHEREAS, the City Council having ascertained the total amount of appropriations legally made for all corporate purposes to be provided for by the tax levy of the current fiscal year;

Now, therefore, be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Nokomis, Illinois:

That there be and there is hereby levied upon all property subject to taxation, both real and personal, within the corporate limits of the City of Nokomis, Illinois, as the same is assessed and equalized for State and County purposes, for the fiscal year ending on the 30th day of April A. The City Clerk of the City of Nokomis is hereby authorized and directed to promptly file a proper certified copy of this tax levy ordinance with the County Clerk of Montgomery County, Illinois, and the said County Clerk is hereby directed and requested to ascertain the rate per cent upon the total valuation of all property subject to taxation within the said City, as that property is assessed and equalized for State and County purposes, will produce a net amount payable to the City of Nokomis, of not less than the amount so levied, and to extend such tax on the book or books for the collector of taxes and cause such tax to be collected in the manner required by statute.
