

ORDINANCE NO. 450

ORDINANCE REGULATING THE PARKING OF VEHICLES
ON EAST UNION STREET, ELM STREET, AND NORTH
SPRUCE STREET IN THE CITY OF NOKOMIS, COUNTY
OF MONTGOMERY AND STATE OF ILLINOIS.

Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Nokomis, Illinois:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any driver of any automobile or other motor vehicle, horsedrawn vehicle, or bicycle, to park said vehicle with the left side of said vehicle next to the curb and it shall also be unlawful to stand or park any said vehicle on East Union Street, Elm Street and North Spruce Street in the City of Nokomis, other than parallel with the Curb and with the two right wheels of the said vehicle within twelve inches of the regularly established curb line on said street.

Section 2. The provisions of this ordinance shall not apply to the driver of vehicles belonging to the City of Nokomis, Illinois, while engaged in the employment of said City; to any driver of any ambulance or other vehicle used solely for emergency work.

Section 3. Penalty) Any person, firm or corporation violating this ordinance shall be fined not less than Three Dollars nor more than Twenty-five Dollars for each offense.

Section 4. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as required by law.
