

ORDINANCE NO. 451

ORDINANCE REGULATING EXCAVATIONS
UNDER PUBLIC STREETS OF NOKOMIS, ILLINOIS

Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Nokomis that:

Section 1. That on or after June 1, A.D. 1956, it shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to make any excavations of any kind or matter under any public streets within the City of Nokomis, Montgomery County, Illinois, unless the excavations so made are backfilled with sand and gravel.

Section 2. Any person, firm or corporation violating any provision of this article shall be fined the sum of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) for each offense.
