Be It Ordained By The City Council of the City of Nokomis, Montgomery County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1. That Section 1 of Ordinance No. 438, being an Ordinance Establishing Rates and Charges for the Services of the Combined Water-works and Sewerage System of the City of Nokomis, Montgomery County, Illinois, and Requiring that Sewerage Connections Be Made to Said System be amended as follows:

## QUARTERLY RATE SCHEDULES

Minimum 3,000 gallons or less	\$ 3.00	\$1.50
Next 7,000 gallons	0.80 per 1000 gals.	0.40 per 1000 gals.

Next 10,000 gallons	0.60 per 1000 gals.	0.30 per 1000 gals.
Next 20,000 gallons	0.50 per 1000 gals.	0.25.per 1000 gals.
Next 50,/gallons	0.40 per 1000 gals.	0.20 per 1000 gala.
Next 100,000 gallons	0.35 per 1000 gals.	0.18 per 1000 gals.
Next 200,000 gallons	0.25 per 1000 gals.	0.13 per 1000 gals.

Whenever any charge for sewerage service is to be made to any lot, parcel of land or premises which is not supplied with water or where there is no water meter, then the quarterly charge shall be \$1.50 per quarter.

Whenever for any cause a water meter fails to operate, a reasonable estimate shall be made by City Clerk of the amount of water supplied
during the period such meter fails to operate and the user shall pay
a rate based in whole or in part on the estimated amount of water
supplied.

SECTION 2. That Section 9. of Ordinance No. 438 be amended as follows: Whenever any lot, parcel of land or premises shall, after the effective date of this ordinance, become connected to the combined waterworks and sewerage system of the City, the following connection Dollars charges shall be imposed. Seventy-five/(\$75.00) shall be charged for connection to a water main. Eighty-two and 50/100 Dollars (\$82.50)

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall be published once in the Free Press-Progress, a newspaper published and having a general circulation in the City of Nokomis, Illinois.
