AN ORDINANCE REGULATING TRAFFIC AT ELM AND EAST UNION STREETS IN THE CITY OF NOKOMIS, ILLINOIS

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Nokomis, Montguery County, Illinois:

Section 1. All operators of any motor vehicle or horse drawn vehicle while traveling upon Elm street in the City of Nokomis, Illinois shall bring said vehicle to a complete stop before entering upon East Union Street in said City and all operators of any motor vehicle or horse drawn vehicle while operating said vehicle upon East Union street in the City of Nokomis, Illinois shall bring said vehicle to a complete stop before entering upon Elm Street in Nokomis, Illinois.

Section 2. Anyone violating the provisions of this Ordinance shall be fined not less than Five Dollars (\$5.00) nor more than Twenty-Five Dollars (\$25.00) for each offense.

This Ordinance shall be in effect immediately after its passage and publication according to law.
