

ORDINANCE NO. 480

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE GROWTH OF WEEDS AND AGRICULTURAL CROPS IN NOKOMIS ILLINOIS.

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Nokomis, Montgomery County, Illinois:

SECTION I. Any owner, lessee, or occupant or any agent, servant, representative or employee of any such owner, lessee, or occupant having control of any lot, block, or tract of land, or any part of such lot, block or tract of land within the limits of said City of Nokomis, who shall allow or maintain on any such lot, any growth of weeds to a height over one foot, shall be deemed guilty of permitting a nuisance on his premises, and upon conviction thereof, shall be fined not less than ten dollars, nor more than one hundred dollars.

SECTION II. The word "weeds" as used herein shall be held to include all rank vegetables or vegetable growth, such as exhale unpleasant and noxious odors, and also high rank vegetation that may conceal filthy deposits, excepting agricultural crops grown over ~~one hundred~~ <sup>Fifty</sup> feet from any residence or dwelling excluding the residence or dwelling occupied by the person planting said agricultural crops.

SECTION III. All ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION IV. This Ordinance shall be in effect immediately after its passage and publication according to law.
