ORDINANCE #<u>48</u>4

AN ORDINANCE RELATIVE TO THE INTRODUCTION OF FLORIDES INTO THE CITY'S WATER SYSTEM.

WHEREAS, it is the opinion of dental and medical groups that the presence of fluoride in drinking water will prevent a large portion of tooth decay; and

WHEREAS, such chemical element is not found in an optimal amount in the natural supply of water distributed to the citizens of the city of Nokomis, Illinois; and

WHEREAS, the prevalence of dental decay may be reduced by adding fluorides to water containing less than the optimal amount,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NOKOMIS, ILLINOIS, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section I

Upon receiving the approval of the State Department of Public

Health, and until further direction of the City Council, the Calybridge Secretary is hereby authorized and directed to provide the means and to proceed with the addition of approximately one and not more than 1.5 parts of fluoride to every million parts of water being distributed in the water supply system of the City of Nokomis, Illinois.
