ORDINANCE NO. 488

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR PARALLEL PARKING ON BOTH SIDES OF NORTH CEDAR STREET IN THE CITY OF NOKOMIS, MONT-GOMERY COUNTY, ILLINOIS

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Nokomis, Montgomery County, Illinois:

SECTION I. That it shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to park any motor vehicle or bicycle upon either side of North Cedar Street in the City of Nokomis, Montgomery County, Illinois, unless the same is parked in a manner parallel to the curb on either side of said street.

SECTION II. Any person, firm or corporation who shall park any motor vehicle or bicycle upon either side of North Cedar Street in the City of Nokomis, Montgomery County, Illinois in violation of the requirements of this ordinance shall for each offense be fined in the sum of not less than Five Dollars (\$5.00) nor more than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) for each offense.

SECTION III. Any Ordinance or Ordinances of the said City of Nokomis now in full force and effect and in conflict with this Ordinance is hereby expressly repealed.

This Ordinance shall be in effect immediately after its passage and publication according to law.
