

ORDINANCE NO. 493

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE CONNECTION OF SANITARY OR INDUSTRIAL WASTE SEWERS TO STORM WATER DRAINAGE SYSTEMS IN THE CITY OF NOKOMIS, MONTGOMERY COUNTY, ILLINOIS.

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Nokomis, Montgomery County, Illinois:

SECTION I. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to connect or cause to be connected, any drain carrying, or to carry, any toilet, sink, basement, septic tank, cesspool, industrial waster, or any fixture or devise discharging polluting substances, to any storm water drain situated in the City of Nokomis, Montgomery County, Illinois.

SECTION II. Any person, firm or corporation violating this ordinance shall be fined not less than Five Dollars (\$5.00) nor more than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) for each offense, and a separate offense shall be deemed committed for each and every day during which a violation continues or exists.

SECTION III. Any Ordinance or Ordinances of the said City of Nokomis now in full force and effect and in conflict with this Ordinance is hereby expressly repealed.

This Ordinance shall be in effect immediately after its passage and publication according to law.
