

ORDINANCE NO. 507

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING LOADING AND UNLOADING AREAS WITHIN THE CITY OF NOKOMIS, MONTGOMERY COUNTY, ILLINOIS AND REGULATION THEREOF.

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Nokomis, Montgomery County, Illinois:

SECTION I. That the City of Nokomis, Montgomery County, Illinois shall establish areas within said City limits of said City of Nokomis, Illinois solely for loading and unloading of goods and merchandise and when said areas shall be established they shall be plainly designated by appropriate markings.

SECTION II. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to park any vehicle within said designated loading and unloading areas at any time unless the same shall be solely for the purpose of loading or unloading goods and merchandise.

SECTION III. Any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be fined not less than Five Dollars (\$5.00) nor more than Twenty Five Dollars (\$25.00) for each offense.

SECTION IV. Any Ordinance or Ordinances of the said City of Nokomis now in full force and effect and in conflict with this Ordinance is hereby expressly repealed.

SECTION V. This ordinance shall become effective thirty (30) days after its passage.
