ORDINANCE NO. 519

AN ORDINANCE CALLING A SPECIAL ELECTION IN THE CITY OF NOKOMIS, MONTGOMERY COUNTY, ILLINOIS, FOR THE PURPOSE OF SUBMITTING TO THE ELECTORS OF SAID VILLAGE THE QUESTION OF ISSUING WATERWORKS BONDS.

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Nokomis, Illinois, finds that it is advisable that the waterworks system of said City be improved by erecting a new tower and water storage tank; and

WHEREAS, the cost of such improvements will be at least Fifty-five Thousand Dollars (\$55,000), and it is advisable that the City be authorized at an election to issue Fifty-five Thousand Dollars (\$55,000) tax-secured Waterworks Bonds for the purpose of constructing such improvements; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary that the question of issuing such bonds be submitted to the legal voters of the City:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NOKOMIS, IL-LINOIS. AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That a special election is hereby called and shall be held in the City of Nokomis, Illinois, on the <u>10th</u> day of <u>September</u>, 1963, for the purpose of submitting to the electors of said City the following proposition:

PROPOSITION

Shall bonds in the amount of Fifty-five Thousand Dollars (\$55,000) be issued by the City of Nokomis, Illinois, for the purpose of paying the cost of erecting a new tower and water storage tank for the City; said bonds to mature as follows:

\$5,000 on December 1, 1964 through 1974

and to bear interest at the rate of 3 1/4% per annum?

SECTION 2. That for said election the entire City shall constitute a single precinct and the polling place shall be the City Hall, Nokomis, Illinois.

SECTION 3. That the polls shall open at six o'clock A.M. and be closed at six o'clock P.M., and said election shall be held and conducted and the return thereof made in like manner as in the case of general elections in said City.

SECTION 4. That the City Clerk shall give notice of said election by publication in the Free Press Progress, a newspaper published in Nokomis, Illinois, not more than thirty (30) days nor less than fifteen (15) days before the date of the election; and such notice shall be in substantially the following form:

Shall bonds in the amount of Fifty-five Thousand Dollars (\$55,000) be issued by the City of Nokomis, Illinois, for the purpose of paying the cost of erecting a new tower and water storage tank for the City; said bonds to mature as follows:

\$5,000 on December 1, 1964 through 1974

and to bear interest at the rate of 3 1/4% per annum?

For said election the entire City shall constitute a single precinct and the polling place shall be the City Hall, Nokomis, Illinois.

The polls will be opened at six o'clock A.M. and will remain open until six o'clock P.M., when they will be closed.

be issued.
