

ORDINANCE NO. 583

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING A PORTION OF PARAGRAPH 3 OF SECTION IV OF ORDINANCE NO. 407 OF THE CITY OF NOKOMIS BEING AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE WATER DEPARTMENT PROVIDING FOR THE INSTALLATION AND MAINTENANCE OF WATER METERS,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NOKOMIS, MONTGOMERY COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

SECTION I

Paragraph Three of Section IV of Ordinance No. 407 of the City of Nokomis, Montgomery County, Illinois, relating to the water department and providing for the installation and maintenance of water meters shall be amended as follows:

All services shall have a shut-off valve in a valve box on the city property, and said service and shut-off valve shall be kept in proper repair by the customer. In the event that the shut-off valve is not operable, the city shall discontinue water service at the customer's expense. In the foregoing paragraph, a customer service shall include all lines and necessary appurtenances from the city water main.

SECTION II

All other provisions of Paragraph Three of Section IV of Ordinance No. 407 shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION III

This amendment shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication according to law. Passed at a regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Nokomis, Montgomery County, Illinois, held at the City Hall in said City on the 16th day of December, A.D., 1968.
