

ORDINANCE NO. 586

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE LITERING OF
STREETS, SIDEWALKS, AND PUBLIC PLACES WITHIN
THE CITY OF NOKOMIS, MONTGOMERY COUNTY, ILLINOIS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NOKOMIS, MONTGOMERY COUNTY, ILLINOIS

SECTION I. That it shall be unlawful for any person, firm, or corporation to throw, cast, lay, or place on any sidewalk, public street, or any other public property in said City any garbage, rubbish, waste, refuse, or any offensive substance.

SECTION II. Any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be fined not less than Ten Dollars (\$10.00) nor more than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) for such offense.

SECTION III. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication according to law.

SECTION IV. All ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.
