

ORDINANCE NO. 600

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING RECKLESS OR CARELESS DRIVING IN THE CITY OF NOKOMIS, MONTGOMERY COUNTY, ILLINOIS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NOKOMIS, MONTGOMERY COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

SECTION 1. That it shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to

operate any motor vehicle including motorcycles or bicycles in the City of Nokomis, Montgomery County, Illinois, in a reckless or wanton manner or carelessly so as

to endanger life or property.

SECTION 2. Any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of

this ordinance shall be fined not less than One Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$150.00) nor more than Three Hundred Dollars (\$300.00) for each offense.

SECTION 3. Any ordinance or ordinances of said City of Nokomis now in

conflict with this ordinance is hereby expressly repealed.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after

its passage, approval and publication according to law.
