ORDINANCE NO. 627

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE POSSESSION AND TRANSPORTATION OF ALCOHOLIC LIQUOR WITHIN THE CITY OF NOKOMIS, ILLINOIS, BE PERSONS UNDER THE AGE OF TWENTY ONE (21) YEARS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NOKOMIS, MONTGOMERY COUNTY, ILLINOIS, THAT:

SECTION 1

It shall be unlawful for any person under the age of twenty one (21) years to transport or have alcoholic liquor in his possession within the City of Nokomis, Montgomery County, Illinois.

SECTION 11

This ordinance shall not apply to the possession and dispensing or consumation by a person under the age of twenty one (21) years of alcoholic liquor in the performance of a religious service or ceremony, or the consumation by such person under the direct supervision and approval of the parents or parent of such person in the privacy of a home.

SECTION III

Any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be fined not less than Twenty Five Dollars (\$25.00) nor more than Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) for each offense.

SECTION IV

Any ordinance or ordinances of said City of Nokomis now in conflict with this ordinance is hereby expressly repealed.

SECTION V

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication according to law.
