

ORDINANCE NO. 630

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE SPEED OF  
TRAINS PASSING THROUGH THE CITY OF  
NOKOMIS, MONTGOMERY COUNTY, ILLINOIS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NOKOMIS, MONTGOMERY COUNTY,  
ILLINOIS, THAT:

SECTION I.

No railroad company, or conductor, engineer, or other employees of such company, managing or controlling any locomotive engine, car or train, shall run or permit to be run within the limits of the City of Nokomis, any locomotive engine, car or train, at a greater rate of speed than forty-five (45) miles per hour.

SECTION II.

Any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be fined not less than Twenty Five Dollars (\$25.00) nor more than Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) for each offense.

SECTION III.

Any ordinance or ordinances of said City of Nokomis now in conflict with this ordinance is hereby expressly repealed.

SECTION IV.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication according to law.
