ORDINANCE NO. 708

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 14 OF ORDINANCE NO. 337 ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE THE SALE OF ALCOHOLIC LIQUOR."

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NOKOMIS, MONTGOMERY COUNTY,

SECTION 1. That Section 14 of Ordinance No. 337, as amended, is hereby further amended by striking said Section 14, and any amendments to said Section, in their entirety and by substituting therefore as follows:

Section 14:

- (a) It shall be unlawful to sell or offer for sale, at retail, any alcoholic liquor in the City between the hours of 12:00 o'clock midnight and 6:00 o'clock A.M. of any day or at any time on Sunday.
- (b) It shall be unlawful to keep open for business or to admit the public to any premises on which alcoholic liquor is sold at retail during the hours within which the sale of such alcoholic liquor is prohibited.

 SECTION 2. All ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

 SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be in effect immediately after its passage and publication according to law.
