ORDINANCE NO. 7/3

AN ORDINANCE LEVYING TAXES FOR ALL CORPORATE PURPOSES FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING MAY 1, 1980, AND ENDING APRIL 30, 1981, FOR THE CITY OF NOKOMIS, MONTGOMERY COUNTY, ILLINOIS.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Commissioners of the City of Nokomis, Montgomery County, Illinois, that:

Section 1.
