AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 747 ESTABLISHING WATER AND SEWER RATES WITHIN AND WITHOUT THE CITY LIMITS AND THE PRICE FOR BULK WATER SOLD TO TANK WAGONS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NOKOMIS MONT-GOMERY COUNTY, STATE OF ILLINOIS:

- SECTION I The City of Nokomis, Illinois amends Article III Water User Charges, Sections 1, 2, 3, and 4 of Ordinance No. 747, passed on August 12, 1985.
- SECTION II The following rates are hereby established for water service, based upon the amount of water each two-month period consumed as shown by water meters:

Up to 1,000 gallons - a minimum charge of \$10.00 For each additional 1,000 gallons the rate will be at \$2.65 per 1,000 gallons metered or fraction thereof.

- SECTION III Users whose premises are outside the corporate limits of the City, shall pay at 25% over the rate set out in Section II.
- SECTION IV Bulk water sold to tank wagons located at a location provided by the City shall be charged at the rate of \$.50 per 100 gallons.
- SECTION V The rate for water supplied to the Village of Coalton: \$2.50 per 1,000 gallons to be billed on a monthly basis.
- SECTION VI Any ordinance or ordinance of said City of Nokomis now in conflict with this ordinance is hereby expressly repealed.
- SECTION VII This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication according to law.
