

ORDINANCE NO. 773

AN ORDINANCE ASCERTAINING
THE PREVAILING RATE OF WAGES
FOR LABORERS, WORKMEN AND MECHANICS
EMPLOYED ON PUBLIC WORKS

WHEREAS the State of Illinois has enacted "An ACT regulating wages of laborers, mechanics and other workmen employed in any public works by the State, county, city or any public body or any political subdivision or by any one under contract for public works," approved June 26, 1941, as amended, being Section 39s-1 through 39s-12, Chapter 48, Illinois Revised Statutes, 1987,

AND WHEREAS the aforesaid Act requires that the City Council of the City of Nokomis investigate and ascertain the prevailing rate of wages as defined in the said Act for laborers, mechanics and other workmen in the locality of the said City employed in performing construction of public works for the said City, exclusive of maintenance work.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NOKOMIS:

Section 1: To the extent and as required by "An ACT regulating wages of laborers, mechanics and other workmen employed in any public works by the State, county, city or any public body or any political subdivision or by any one under contract for public works," approved June 26, 1941, as amended, the general prevailing rate of wages in this locality for laborers, mechanics and other workmen engaged in the con-

struction of public works coming under the jurisdiction of this City is hereby ascertained to be the same as the prevailing rate of wages for construction work in the Montgomery County area as determined by the Department of Labor of the State of Illinois as of June, 1989, a copy of that determination being incorporated herein by reference. The definition of any terms appearing in this ordinance which are also used in the aforesaid Act shall be the same as in the said Act.

Section 2: Nothing herein contained shall be construed to apply the said general prevailing rate of wages as herein ascertained to any work or employment except public works construction of this City to the extent required by the aforesaid Act.

Section 3: The City Clerk shall publicly post or keep available for inspection by any interested party in the main office of this City this determination of such prevailing rate of wage.

Section 4: The City Clerk shall mail a copy of this determination to any employer (and to any association of employers) and to any person or association of employees who have filed, or file, their names and addresses, requesting copies of any determination stating the particular rates and the particular class of workmen whose wages will be affected by such rates.

Section 5: The City Clerk shall promptly file a certified copy of this ordinance with the Secretary of State of Illinois.

Section 6: The City Clerk shall cause to be published in a newspaper of general circulation within the area a copy of this ordi-

nance, and such publication shall constitute notice that the determination is effective and that this is the determination of this public body.







ILLINOIS DEPARTMENT OF LABOR PREVAILING WAGES FOR MONTGOMERY COUNTY EFFECTIVE 06/01/89

These Prevailing Wages shall be included in the contracts and their advertised specifications to which any public body, as defined in Section 2 of the Prevailing Wage Act (Ill. Rev. Stat., 1987, Ch. 48, par. 305.1), is a party, for the construction, reconstruction, maintenance and/or repair of public buildings or public works within the State of Illinois which require or involves the employment of laborers, workers, and mechanics, and owner/operators. Minimum wages, overtime rate and fringe benefits certified herein shall be paid. This scale of prevailing wages to be paid shall be posted by the contractor in a prominent and easily accessible place at the site of work. This determination is the property of the Illinois Department of Labor and shall not be altered without their consent in writing.
